	GCSE textbooks purchased for pupils who need extra texts to support their learning.	£1250
	Easter revision classes.	£2919

2	Year 11 mentoring.	£5600
	Careers support and advice from careers advisor in school.	£2300
	Subsidies for trips for educational purposes.	£1000
	Subsidised of fully funded music lessons building on the strong links between learning an instruments and academic progress.	£500
