Rhyme Time – A music and rhyme themed session where children can develop their language and communication skills by singing along to their favourite songs and nursery rhymes.

Stay and Play for Under 1's - This session aims to support developing babies to grow and learn. Activities will encourage babies to reach their developmental milestones, following their interests and curiosities.

BreastStart Group – Come and join us in a relaxed friendly environment, chat and meet other breastfeeding mums and get some support and advice. A member of the health visiting team supports the group along with a parent volunteer. Pregnant ladies also welcome. Opportunity to self-weigh for Breastfeeding mums.

Movers and Shakers - Is a fun music and movement session which supports and develops children's communication and physical skills. The session includes using musical instruments and singing to support early language development and physical activities such as scarves, bubbles, balls and parachute games to develop co-ordination and physical awareness.

Keepsakes - This group will offer an opportunity for families to make a variety of 'keepsake' items with their children, combined with an opportunity to get to know the Children's Centre team and learn more about what the Children's Centre can offer.

Little Wishes Stay and Play - Bring your pre-schoolers, chat with other parents and have a cuppa as your children play in our themed weekly sessions. Children are given a drink and a healthy snack, and we also run a book swap. Fun, friendly and free, run by volunteer parents. Term time only. Themed sessions advertised on facebook.

Meet and Greet – Meet Steph our Parent Champion, who is happy to show you around the centre.

Our skills development service, works with parents who want to make positive changes for themselves and their families. The service offers encouragement and practical support with trying new things and getting more involved, often leading to Learning, Training, Volunteering and Employment.
