## These notes should be read before making a grant application

This Charity owes its origins to the late Ralph Parrish who on his death bequeathed his Estate to the Foundation. It was his wish that the Charity should provide educational grants for students in higher and further education and financial assistance to those in genuine need. Claimants must reside within the boundaries of East Lindsey District Council.

The Foundation is administered by the Trustees, free of any charges, who make every effort to keep expenditure to an absolute minimum in order to maximise the funds available for charitable purposes. The Trustees do not have the time or resources to do anything other than make a decision to approve or reject a grant application based on the initial information provided. It is therefore essential that initial applications provide comprehensive personal and financial details. Inadequate information leaving questions to be asked will normally be rejected.

To save time and expense the Trustees only contact successful applicants. You can assume your application has been unsuccessful if you have not heard from them within 14 days. The Trustees will accept third party applications, but again they expect such applications to provide comprehensive information at the outset.
